

Transition to School-age Programs

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If your child will be kindergarten age in your school district this fall and YOU WANT YOUR CHILD IN KINDERGARTEN. . .

- In February, go to the Early Intervention Transition meeting
- Sign the school district's Intent to Register form
- Give permission to:
 - transfer records
 - evaluate
 - develop the IEP

If your child will be kindergarten age in your school district this fall and YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD IN KINDERGARTEN. . .

- Go to the Transition meeting
- On the Intent to Register form, mark that you WILL NOT REGISTER

A preschool IEP will be developed later and your child's education will remain the responsibility of the preschool special education agency.

Then...

At 1st grade age...

- Attend the February transition meeting
- Sign the school district Intent to Register form
- Give permission to:
 - transfer records
 - evaluate
 - develop the IEP

If you are unsure about sending your child to kindergarten, you have until May 15th to decide. Talk with other parents about their experiences. Observe classes and programs.
