

Curriculum Map: ES 4th Grade Technology

Course: Computer4 Sub-topic: Computer

Grade(s): 4

Course Description: Throughout the year, students in 4th grade will use Type to Learn, a comprehensive keyboarding software program that provides guided lessons and practice exercises to help students develop their typing skills. The program is designed to introduce students to the QWERTY keyboard layout and help them achieve proficiency in typing speed and accuracy.

In addition to keyboarding, students will also learn how to use Google Docs, a cloud-based word processing tool that allows them to create, edit, and collaborate on documents online. Students will learn how to create and format text documents, including using basic formatting tools such as font styles, sizes, and colors. They will also learn how to use Google Docs to share and collaborate on documents with peers and teachers.

Throughout the year, students will have the opportunity to apply their keyboarding and Google Docs skills in real-world scenarios, such as creating reports, writing letters, and collaborating on class projects. By the end of the year, students will have developed strong keyboarding skills and a basic understanding of word processing tools, setting them up for success in future technology use.

Unit: 9 Week Keyboard Program TTL 4 Group Blocks

Timeline: Week 34

Unit Description: Students will visit technology class for 9 weeks at a time and focus on Keyboarding for 40 minutes a day. Weeks 1-4 focus on Type To Learn , Weeks 4-7 move to QWERTY Keyboarding and the final 2 weeks take the skills learned throughout the course to work on Google Docs projects.
