**By appointment only - No walk-ins**

**Masks must be worn by the enrolling student and the adult**

**Due to Covid restrictions we ask that only 1 parent/guardian attend with the student.**

\*Children who are 5 years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> are eligible to start kindergarten in the 2021-2022 school year.

When you come to registration you will need to bring the following:

- Completed Registration packet
- Your child's original birth certificate
- Proof of Residency in the Wyalusing Area School District
  - This can be any document that shows your name and street address to indicate you live in our district. Examples are: lease, current tax bill, or current utility bill.
- Custody and Guardianship documentation (if applicable)
- Your child's immunization records
  - Commonwealth of Pennsylvania requires the following immunization for new entries into kindergarten:
    - 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (1 dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday).
    - 4 doses of polio (4<sup>th</sup> dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)
    - 2 doses of measles, mumps, and rubella
    - 3 doses of hepatitis B
    - 2 doses of varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or evidence of immunity
